Summer Camp Volunteer Assistant:

Energetic, outgoing, fun-loving, dependable, mature, well-organized individuals wanted to assist camp teachers with young campers. **The camp day is 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday. Volunteers are welcome to help all day or in one of two shifts –8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. or 12 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. Camps begin June 8th through the week of August 17. We welcome repeat weeks of service, as your summer schedule allows.**

Qualifications: Currently a high school student with some interest in science and helping children learn. Ability to enforce camp rules and regulations while supervising campers ages 5-13 a must. Previous work/volunteer experience involving caring for or teaching children a definite plus. The ideal camp volunteer is a positive role model for the campers by encouraging respect for personal property, camp equipment, facilities, other campers and instructors. The Health Museum is looking for self-motivated, friendly, adaptable teens with a good sense of humor and a concern for and enjoyment of children. A summer camp volunteer must be willing to participate in all aspects of a camper's day with enthusiasm, a sense of fun and interest in creating an engaging environment for the children.

Responsibilities: The camp volunteer helps monitor a group of children assigned to a camp between the ages of 5 and 13. The main responsibility of the position is to assist with camp activities, keep track of the children and keep them safe.
